Counsel. Today, we will vote to approve LU 52, the

Sutter Place NCP project in Brooklyn, Council

Districts represented by Council Member Nurse and

Council Member Barron. The application requests

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designation of an Urban Development Action Area,
approval of an Urban Development Action Area Project
for such areas, and approval of a disposition of
city-owned property to a developer to be selected by
HPD to facilitate the development of 4 buildings
containing approximately 46 affordable housing units
and ground floor commercial space.

We will vote to approve LUs 61 and 62 related to a proposed new EMS Station 17 facility related to property in Council Member Stevens' district in the Bronx. The proposal requests approval of a site selection of property located at 1257 Morris Avenue for use as a new emergency medical service station as well as approval for the grant of a zoning special permit to allow the EMS station use in a residential district.

We will also vote to approve LUs 65 and 66 related to the 98th Third Avenue Rezoning Proposal in Council Member Restler's district in Brooklyn. The proposal includes a zoning map amendment to rezone an M1-2 district to an R7D/C2-4 and R6B district and a rezoning text amendment to establish an MIH program area utilizing Option 1 and Option 2.

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We will also vote to approve with modifications LUs 63 and 64 for the 4541 Furman Avenue rezoning in Council Member Dinowitz's district in the Bronx. This proposal includes a zoning map amendment to rezone an M1-1 district to an R7D/C2-4 district and a related zoning text amendment to establish an MIH program utilizing Option 1 and 2. Our modification will be to eliminate the proposed transit zone extension.
