5	Comrie, chairing the Land Use Committee. We are
6	joined by Council Member James Sanders, Stephen
7	Levin, Mark Weprin, Brad Lander, Jimmy Vacca,
8	Robert Jackson, Diana Reyna, Jumaane Williams,
9	Peter Koo, Inez Dickens, Larry Seabrook and
LO	Charles Barron.
11	We have a few items on today's
12	calendar. The first are three school sitings, one
L3	in Council Member Ferreras' district; it's I.S.
L4	311 Queens in Queens Community Board 4, Item No.
L5	20105361 SCQ. It's to build an 800 seat
L6	intermediate school at 97-36 43 rd Avenue in
L7	Community School District 24.
L8	The next one is in Council Member
L9	Chin's district. It's to build a primary school.
20	It's going to be called the Peck Slip School.
21	This is Manhattan Community Board 1, Item No.
22	20115806 SCM, and that's to be a school located at
23	1 Peck Slip in the borough of Manhattan, Community
24	School District 2.
25	The next one is in Speaker Quinn's

district. It's going to be called the West 43 rd
High School at this time; Manhattan Community
Board 4, Item No. 20125005 SCM. It's going to be
the Beacon School replacement to be located at 530
West 44 th Street in Manhattan Community District 2.

We also have one other school siting in Council Member Ferreras' district. It's going to be a 1100 seat primary school facility—it's a big school—Item No. 20125006 SCQ. It will be located at 96-18 43rd Avenue, also in Community School District 24.

We have a couple of items from planning. It's an amendment to the Zoning Map,
Land Use Item 429, known as Teddy's Bar and Grill,
Item No. C080491 ZMK, in Council Member Levin's
district, Brooklyn Community Board 1. It is to
establish an amendment to the Zoning Maps No. 12c
by establishing an existing R6-B district within a
C2-4 district, and it's going to be modified to
move the boundary from midway between North 9th and
North 10th to midway between North 8th and North 9th
Streets, and those details will be shown in the
resolution text.

Our next item is Land Use Item No.

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430 in Council Member Halloran's district. I	t's
also an amendment to the Zoning Map in Queens	
Community Board 7, Item No. C100175 ZMQ. Thi	s is
an application to establish a TD Bank, which	will
be located on the Cross Island Parkway service	е
road just north of 15 th Avenue and 148 th Street	

The next item we have are Landmarks items; Land Use No. 431 in Council Member Reyna's district, St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Brooklyn Community Board 1, Item No. 20115689 HKK. It's to landmark the St. Paul's Church, Sunday School and Parsonage located at 334 South 5th Street and 306-312 Rodney Street. It's to become a historic landmark.

The next item is a Landmark in Council Member Levin's district. It's Land Use Item No. 432, 20115756 HKK. It's to landmark the property that was Brooklyn Union Gas' headquarters located at 176 Remsen Street as a historic landmark in Brooklyn Community Board 2.

Then we have the last item on today's agenda, which is a Landmark in Council Member Lappin's District, Land Use Item No. 433 in Manhattan Community Board 6, Item No. 20115757

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2 HKM. It's to landmark the free public baths of
3 the city of New York located at East 54th Street
4 and including a gymnasium located at 342 and 348
5 East 54th Street.
