We have been joined by Council Members Farah Louis, Adrienne Adams, Robert Cornegy, Keith Powers, our Minority Leader Steve Matteo, Council Member Barry Grodenchik and Council Member Jimmy Van Bramer. Today the Committee has eight land use items on the agenda. The first is HCCI 2 in Council Member Perkin, Perkins's district in Manhattan. This action would provide a full 40-year Article XI property tax exemption to support the preservation of 399 units of affordable rental housing. The second is HCCI 2 phase II also in Council Member Perkins's district. This action would provide a full 40-year Article XI property tax exemption to support the preservation of 207 units of affordable rental housing. The third is in... I think it's Jamie's Place Apartments which are in Council Member Ayala's district. This action would amend a council resolution from June 2018 to increase the subsidy in a partial 40-year Article XI property tax exemption to support the preservation of 126 units of affordable rental housing.
