

<u>Int 141-A – Local Law 32</u>

In relation to commercial recycling.

Int 142-A – Local Law 33

In relation to a paint stewardship pilot program.

Int 147-A - Local Law 34

In relation to recycling outreach, education and enforcement; and to repeal subdivisions d and e of section 16-305 and section 16-311 of the administrative code of the city of New York, relating to source separation of recyclable materials and recycling centers.

Int 148-A – Local Law 35

In relation to the designation of rigid plastic containers as recyclable materials, and to repeal subdivision c of section 16-305 of the administrative code of the city of New York, relating to staggering the source separation and collection of designated recyclable materials.

Int 156-A - Local Law 36

In relation to recycling by city agencies.

<u>Int 157-A – Local Law 37</u>

In relation to yard waste.

<u>Int 158-A – Local Law 38</u>

In relation to public space recycling and a citywide textile reuse and recycling program, and the repeal and reenactment of section 16-310 of the administrative code of the city of New York, relating to batteries and tires.

<u>Int 162-A – Local Law 39</u>

In relation to household hazardous waste collection.

Int 164-A - Local Law 40

In relation to recycling goals, and to repeal section 16-304, subdivisions a and b of section 16-305 and subchapter three of chapter 3 of title 16 of the administrative code of the city of New York, relating to department-disposed of solid waste, department-collected solid waste and a recycling plan.

<u>Int 165-A – Local Law 41</u>

In relation to recycling in public and private schools.

<u>Int 171-A – Local Law 42</u>

In relation to the composting of food waste.

Int 194-A – Local Law 43

In relation to use of clean heating oil in New York City.
