Proposed Resolution 370-A: set September 16th, 10
a.m. as the date/time to consider a Local Law that would authorize the 34th Street BID in the
Speaker's district to provide additional services in the BID district, change the method of assessment upon which the district charge is based and increase the maximum amount that can be used for capital improvements in the district.

As is the practice with the BIDs in the Speaker's district, in order to provide time

for the public to comment, the Speaker will not comment on the BID item until closure to the hearing date, which will be September 16th.

Our last piece of legislation relates to the adopted Fiscal 2011 Expense Budget, which we adopted on June 29th of this year. This transparency resolution mostly adds three new initiatives and makes technical corrections to the designations listed in Schedule C. The resolution also makes changes to designations made in Fiscal 2010 Expense Budget. Council Members should have the list of these changes and in some cases additions, which is attached to the resolution.

For clarification purposes, it is to be noted that organizations appear in the resolutions that have not yet complete the prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services, by the Council or other government agencies are identified in the attached charts with an asterisk.

Additionally, as will all transparency resolutions, Council Members will have to sign a disclosure form indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any of the groups on
