In relation to requiring that all proposed rules be reviewed by the law department and the mayor's office of operations.

Int 262-A - Local Law 47

In relation to reducing unnecessary artificial lighting in lobbies and hallways.

<u>Int 266-A – Local Law 48</u>

In relation to energy efficiency in commercial buildings.

Int 267-A - Local Law 49

In relation to including environmental concerns as an interest of the New York City Building Code.

In relation to establishing a silver alert program to provide public notification for missing senior citizens with certain cognitive impairments.

<u>Int 273-A – Local Law 51</u>

In relation to lighting of temporary walkways at construction sites.

Int 312 - Local Law 53

In relation to amending the district plan of the 34th Street business improvement district to authorize additional services and modify existing services for the district, to change the method of assessment upon which the district charge is based and to increase the maximum total amount to be expended for improvements in the districts.
