1 SUBCOMM ON LANDMARKS, PUB SITING, MARITIME USES 4 garage in Community Board Three, Nostrand Avenue, 2 3 has been an ongoing issue for the last three decades. And this particular matter, at the end cannot be resolved because of the unwillingness of 5 the Department of Sanitation with the 6 Administration to prioritize this. I am not an 7 8 unreasonable individual, I was looking for commitments of making sure that this garage would 9 10 be built in our lifetime. In my last effort to work with the Department of Sanitation and the 11 12 Administration a seven year lease was granted when I had been the representative of Community Board 13 14 Three and this particular garage. Today, East 15 Williamsburg, the manufacturing industrial park, is home to 16 waste transfer stations, three 16 17 different community boards host their garages for 18 sanitation trucks to park their vehicles within 19 this zone. While we're talking about health 20 disparities, this is the number one area that 21 affects our environment. And when we look for the 22 swampland to be implemented, it cannot carve out 23 the garage for Community Board Three to be built I want it to be noted that I'm very 24 25 disappointed and frustrated at the process that

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CHAIRPERSON LANDER: Thank you,

Council Member. I just want to note as well that Community Board Three is on record, eager to have a new Sanitation Garage built within their confines. It's not often necessarily that a community says, "Yes, please build a, you know, build the sanitation garage in our, in our community, " and they deserve credit for being willing to bear the burden that goes along with good public services. And I know that Councilwoman James who chairs the Sanitation Committee, this is an important issue for her, as are the other sanitation garages that everyone agrees needs to get built, and hopefully we can get the resources to do so, moving quickly. And we've spoken with her and hope that she'll be able to work with the Administration to accelerate the day when we can build the new garage in Community Board Three, and also the other five sanitation garages that need to be built around the City. With that, we'll move forward on the Motion to File Pursuant to Withdrawal. The Chair recommends a vote of aye.
