my name is Erik Dilan and I'm the Chairman of the City Council's Housing and Buildings Committee.

Today the committee will conduct a hearing for the purpose of a vote on a Preconsidered bill which would amend the Local Law 29 for the year of 2007, which is the Alternative Enforcement Program which was sponsored by Council Member James. This would give the Department of Housing Preservation and Development until January 31st of 2011 to implement requirements of the Alternative Enforcement Program for the upcoming calendar year 2011.

The Preconsidered bill would give
HPD, as I said, up 'til January 31st of next year
to select multiple dwellings for the fourth round
of the program and would notify the owners of
selected properties of their participation or
selection in the program. Normally, the selection
would occur this month, and this bill will provide
for an extension for round four selections because
of a future bill that this committee expects to
hear regarding proposed changes to the program.
