19	property located at blocks 2282/lot 45 and 75,
20	2283/lot 40, in Council District 8.

22	District, Land Use Item 269 in Bronx Community
23	Board 12, item number 20Community Board 2
24	20115304 HAX. It's also an application for
25	property tax exemptions for a regulatory agreement

- 9 We have two landmark items, one in
- 10 Council Member Chin's district, landmark item
- 11 | number 270, the 97 Bowery Building, item number
- 12 20115269 HKM, in Manhattan Community Board 23.
- 13 It's a landmark designation of the 97 Bowery
- Building to be deemed a historic landmark. Also
- 15 Land Use Item number 271, in Council Member
- 16 Mendez's district, Manhattan Community Board 3
- 17 also, item number 20115270 HKM. It's to landmark
- 18 the 11th Street Methodist Episcopal Chapel,
- 19 | located at 545-547 East 11th Street as a historic
- 20 landmark.

If not, we will have to come back tomorrow morning and both the--both committees, Zoning and the Full Land Use Committee would have to vote tomorrow. So I would encourage you all to talk to the Council Member whose district it's in to try to get her to agreement this morning so we can vote this afternoon. Ιf anybody would like to remember who that is, it's the Council Member on the West Side of Manhattan. So you can encourage her to get to--first name starts with a G, yeah.
