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Morning everyone, good morning. My name is Mark Weprin, and I chair of the Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises of the Land Use Committee. We have a busy morning today. It's going to be the Subcommittee followed by Land Use, and I know there's a Finance hearing in this very room, so we're going to try to push ahead. I'm delighted to be joined this morning by the following members of the Subcommittee: Council Member Joel Rivera, Council Member Leroy Comrie, Council Member Robert Jackson, Council Member Larry Seabrook, Council Member Jessica Lappin, who just stepped out, but will be right back in, Council Member James Vacca. COUNCIL MEMBER VACCA: Yes, I'm

here.

CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: And we might be joined by some other distinguished council members as we move on and we have two items that are related on the agenda. We already had the hearing on this item. They are Land Use Nos. 325 and 326, the Webster Avenue/Bedford Park/Norwood re-zoning in the Bronx, Community Boards 7 and 12. We are very lucky to have with us today some of

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the council members who represent this area, and we're going to ask if they would like to say a few words. We are also joined by Council Member Reyna before I do that and I'd like to ask Council Member Koppell, who represents this area to say a few words.

COUNCIL MEMBER KOPPELL: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I know this was on the agenda before and one constituent of mine, a resident of the area, raised some issues in fact were relevant to the basic re-zoning, but the Committee was very considerate in giving some time to consider those objections and I want to say to you, Mr. Chairman and members, I appreciate your coming for this sort of special meeting of the Subcommittee so that we could move this along at this stated meeting today. This particular re-zoning has a unanimous support of the Community Board. It was done with the Bronx Office of City Planning. was done in consultation with the community. Wе already have considerable inquiries from developers interested in building housing, including affordable housing, which is something that we very much welcome. Webster Avenue is a

unfortunately underutilized strip that I think with this re-zoning is going to see some real revitalization. The Norwood Community in which it lies already has a fair amount of rebuilding going on or new building and so this is a really positive step. Again, I want to thank the members for taking the time to hear this this morning.
