usher in a just world that rejects discrimination, inequality, and poverty. His message inspired people across the nation and their contributions propelled the movement that continues to influence the nation. We each bear the responsibility to advance these efforts and grow the seeds of progress to bestow upon future generations. This obligation means we have to confront longstanding inequities which have been a focus for this body. From maternal and mental health, to community safety, and victim services this Council has taken a comprehensive approach that prioritizes solutions to the challenges facing New Yorkers. Although the equitable future we seek may take a years, and even decades to achieve, every ounce of progress we secure today will bring us closer as we struggle for equity and justice.

Next, I want to recognize several holidays that are important for our city's diverse communities:

January 1st was Haitian Independence Day which commemorates Haiti's liberation from colonial rule in 1804, as the world's first Black-led Republic. To our members of Haitian descent, and all Haitian New Yorkers, I hope you had a wonderful Haitian Independence Day.

January 6th was Three Kings Day, a significant holiday that is also known as the Feast of Epiphany. For many New Yorkers, the holiday season does not end on Christmas but on Three Kings Day where family members gather to exchange gifts and share meals together. I hope that everyone who celebrated had a happy Three Kings Day.

January 13th was Korean-American Day which commemorates the day in 1903 when the first Koreans arrived in the United States. Our historically diverse council includes the first two Korean-American council members in Linda Lee and Julie Won. We celebrate your historic representation, and we wish all New Yorkers a happy Korean-American Day.

January 15th, is special to me as a sister of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated. And this year, we celebrate 116 years of sisterhood, scholarship, and service. I'm so proud to be a life member of Alpha Kappa Alpha. And I am joined with our own majority leader as a sorority sister in Amanda Farías. On Monday, we lit up One World Trade Center in pink and green, a moment that we will always remember. Happy Founders Day to all of my sorors.

On January 22nd, we will observe Roe v. Wade Day, which marks the anniversary of the landmark Supreme Court decision that granted us the federally protected safe and legal abortions. This year would have been the 51st anniversary of Roe v. Wade, but with the Supreme Court's actions to overturn five decades of legal precedent, reproductive healthcare for millions of people is under attack across this country.

Our women majority Council has prioritized safeguarding and expanding access to abortion care by passing the New York City Abortion Rights Act and investing and unprecedented \$1 million in municipal funds to support abortion care access for those who cannot afford it.

York City remains a beacon of hope, but we know more must be done across the country to ensure everyone can safely and legally access abortions and reproductive health care.

And January 27th is Holocaust Remembrance Day when we honor the memory of millions of Jewish people and other victims who were murdered during the Holocaust. We uplift their memories and do make a solemn pledge Never Again.

This body 12 recognized the former member, the late Al Vann, last 13 year; Dr. Flateau worked for and closely with him, 14 along with New York's first Black mayor, David 15 Dinkins. And whenever there has been Black greatness in Brooklyn, Dr. Flateau's influence was never far 16 17 away. Much of the equity we have achieved, and even 18 what is yet to come, is thanks in large part to Dr. 19 Flateau. I and all of Brooklyn am so very sorry to 20 have lost him, and I extend my deepest condolences to 21 his family.
