Proposed Introduction 126-A would require that
the Fire Department provide body armor to employees
within the Bureau of Emergency Medical Services
providing emergency medical services. Such body armor
will be required to meet ballistic and stab resistant
standards.

Proposed Introduction 127-A would require the

Fire Department to provide de-escalation and selfdefense training to its employees providing medical
services within the Bureau of Emergency Medical

Services. Such training would be available at least
once every third calendar year. This would be in
addition to any defense training EMS workers receive
when they start at the Department.

As this committee's chair, I will always fight to protect the safety and well-being of our first responders. Our City's EMS workers are one of the most, if not the most, underserved part of our municipal workforce. By passing these bills today, I believe we are increasing their safety as they work their jobs here in the City of New York. We need to protect our City's EMS workforce.
