CHAIRPERSON RILEY: [GAVEL] Good morning, everyone, and welcome to a meeting of the Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises. I am Council Member Kevin Riley, Chair of the Subcommittee. This morning, I am joined by Council Members Moya, Abreu, Schulman, and remotely by council Member Carr.

Today, we will vote on one proposal, Willets Point Phase II.

Before we begin, I recognize the Subcommittee Counsel to review the hearing procedures.

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COMMITTEE COUNSEL VIDAL: Thank you, Chair
Riley. I'm William Vidal, Counsel to the
Subcommittee.

This meeting is being held in hybrid format. Council Members who would like to ask questions or make a statement should either indicate so verbally or, if participating remotely, by using the Zoom raise hand function. The Chair will recognize Members to speak.

Chair Riley will now continue with today's agenda items.

CHAIRPERSON RILEY: Thank you, Counsel. As we heard at last month's public hearing on March 12, Willets Point Phase II is a transformative project that will bring to New York City its first stadium dedicated to soccer, or should I say football, and create hundreds of units of much-needed affordable housing. This project consists of LUs 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34. Together, these actions will transform Willets Point, which for decades was a hub for auto body shops, into a new neighborhood. This re-

Council Member Moya has been a champion of this project for many, many years and fully approves this proposal, and I will now like to give the floor to Council Member Moya to give his remarks.

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2 COUNCIL MEMBER MOYA: Thank you. Good 3 morning. Thank you so much, Chair Riley, and to all 4 my Colleagues who are here today. I am very excited to be here to discuss an important project that will greatly benefit our community, not just in Queens, 6 7 but in the City of New York. When I became a Council Member in 2017, I promised to make affordable housing 8 a top priority, and that's exactly what this project delivers. Today, we are voting to approve 1,400 units 10 11 of 100 percent affordable housing which means homes 12 that people can actually afford and many units 13 reserved for low-income seniors and formerly homeless individuals combining with Phase I that is already 14 15 under construction to total 2,500 units of affordable 16 housing. This is definitely a huge step in solving 17 the housing crisis that is hitting our city, but we 18 are creating more than just housing here. The plan also includes a new 650-seat elementary school to 19 20 relieve overcrowding at nearby schools, there will be 21 new open spaces, retail stores, and a 250-room hotel. 2.2 The ground jewel will be the first privately financed 2.3 electric soccer stadium built with 100 percent union labor with 35 percent M/WBE goals. These additions 24 will generate over 1,500 permanent jobs and 14,000-25

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plus construction jobs. We're not just building homes

but economic opportunities for thousands of New

I want to take this opportunity to thank Speaker Adams. I also would like to thank Mayor Adams for his partnership and his support and his vision as well as to the New York City Football Club who, like me, never stopped believing that Queens would be their home, to my brothers and sisters in labor, our partners at EDC, the Queens Development Group, and the dedicated community leaders in the Willets Point Task Force whose support is essential for this project that checks every box, affordable housing, good jobs, economic growth, and community benefits. This truly is a game-changer for New York, and I want to say thank you to the entire Land Use Staff here at the New York City Council for their dedication and years of working on this project and with me as well, and I also want to, in particular, thank my Chief-of-Staff, Meghan Tadio, who has done a tremendous job in making this happen. This would not have been realized without you, Tadio, so thank you for that, and thank you, Chair, for the opportunity to be here and vote in the affirmative.
