**COMMITTEE:** State and Federal Legislation

**Title:** AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the use of bicycles for

commercial purposes.

**SPONSORS:** Council Member Foster

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: The bill would make commercial bicycle operators and the business affiliated with such operators liable for moving violations and reckless driving while delivering the business products. This bill would also require the affiliated businesses to provide identification for the cyclist, with the use of an identification card. Additionally, an obvious visual means of identification with the name of the establishment or a registered number identified solely with a particular business address must be supplied to the commercial cyclist.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
