CHAIRPERSON COMRIE: We have a few items on the agenda today, so I'll try to move through them quickly. The first is a motion to file pursuant to withdrawal for a sidewalk café located in Brooklyn Community Board 15, known as the OPM Restaurant and Club, Land Use No. 405, Item No. 20115564 TCK. Second item is for approval, sidewalk café in Council Member Mendez's district, Item No. 406 Percy's Tavern, Item No. 20115563 TCM, Manhattan Community Board 3. It's to establish an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 210 Avenue A. The next three are sidewalk cafés--La Esquina in Council Member Chin's district, Land Use No. 414, Item No. 20115455 TCM. It's to continue to maintain an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 114 Kenmare Street. The

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The next one is a 164th Street rezoning in Council Member Gennaro's district, Land Use No. 413 in Queens Community Board 8, Item No. C090347 ZMQ. It's an amendment to the zoning map to facilitate construction of a two story commercial building located within an existing R3-2 district bounded by a line 150th Street southerly of 69th Avenue alignment bay between 164th and 165th Street aligned 290 feet southerly of 69th Avenue and 164th Street as shown on the diagram. The next one is Land Use Item 417. It's called the Solow Center in Council Member Koo's district, Community Board 7. It's an amendment to the zoning map to facilitate the development of a seven story mixed use building. It's Item No. C070210 ZMO and it would change an M1 district to an R6 district

property and establish within the proposed R6
district, a C2-2 district and I won't read the
full diagram of the boundaries. The next one is
Land Use Items 418 and 419-they're related. They
are in Council Member Ignizio's district. They're
the Woodrow Plaza rezoning, Item No. C080482 ZMR.
There's two related applications an amendment to
the zoning map and amendment to the zoning text-to
facilitate the development of two commercial
buildings and the reconfigured parking lot. The
text amendment for Woodrow Plaza is Land Use No.
419, Item No. 080483 ZRR. Next item is a motion
to file pursuant to withdrawal, Land Use No. 420,
Linden Boulevard rezoning in Community Board 13,
Item C0100342 ZMQ. It's to withdraw an
application for a modification at 226 Street and
Linden Boulevard. The next items 421, 422 and 423
are related around the Sunnyside/Woodside rezoning
in Council Member Van Bramer's district
modified, Queens Community Board 2, Item No.
C100207 ZMQ. The three related applicationsan
amendment to the zoning map and two text
amendments to preserve the built character and
encourage the appropriate development; the

modification is to the allowed height and FAR on
Queens Boulevard and the corresponding
inclusionary housing change. That's three items
as I saidLand Use Item 421, 422 and 423, with

the numbers N100208 ZRQ and N100209 ZRQ.

The last item is a school siting in Council Member Ulrich's district. It's a school siting. It will be called P.S. 316 in Community Board 9, Item No. 20115507 SCQ. It will be located at the northeast and northwest corners of 90th Street and 101st Avenue. With that, the next Subcommittee meetings are scheduled for July 25th.
