
McGovern Florist (formerly Weir Greenhouse)

REASONS FOR ACQUISITION, RESTORATION AND REUSE.

- 1. Since 1895, the McGovern/Weir building has graced the approach to the historic Green-Wood gates and Gothic Arch
- 2. In 1980, the building was made an Individually Designated NYC Landmark
 - Property allowed to deteriorate over the years to its current decrepit condition
 - Green-Wood will restore the Landmark and build new adjacent offices
 - Individually Designated NYC Landmark would now be tied to a National Historic Landmark

3. Potential Uses:

- Offices, to allow more space in cemetery for new interments
- Exhibit space for Green-Wood's extensive art and Historic Fund collection
- Visitor / Welcome Center at street level
- 4. Ideally located near NYC subway (R train) and Green-Wood's visitor parking area
- 5. Surrounded by a manufacturing use M-1 district, with limited community impact
