This meeting comes to order. Today we're going to be voting on two proposed resolutions. Resolution No. 870-A and proposed Resolution 999-A, but first let me introduce the Council Members that are here--Council Member Weprin and Council Member Brewer.

Council Member Vallone, a resolution calling on the United States Congress to pass and the precedent to sign into law the Public Safety

Spectrum and Wireless Innovation Act, which amends the Communications Act of 1934 to provide public safety providers an additional ten megahertz of spectrum to support a national interoperative [phonetic] wireless broadband network and authorizes the Federal Communications Commission to hold incentive auctions to provide funding to support such a network.

Proposed Resolution 999-A is a resolution by yours truly pursuant to Section 104C of the New York State General Municipal Law authorizing New York City Department of City-Wide Administrative Services to donate surplus city-
