River Arts Center in Bronx Community Board 6, Item
No. C 110366 HAX. It's to provide emergency
access purposes existing Bronx River Arts
Center. We have two third party transfers; one in
Council Member Jackson's district, Community Board
9, Land Use No. 497, Item No. 20125124 HAM. We
also have a third party transfer, Land Use No.
498, which effects Council Members Mendez,
Dickens, Jackson and Mark-Viverito in Community

Item No. 20125125 HAM. We have some sidewalk
