will receive a tax exemption from HPD, which will

allow it to continue to provide 86 units of rental

housing to low-income New Yorkers. Council Member

Melissa Mark-Viverito supports this item.

Our next item related to adopted fiscal 2011/2012 expense budget. This resolution sets forth new designations or changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local aging and youth discretionary funding as

well as new designation or changes in the		
designation of certain organizations receiving		
funds pursuant to certain initiatives in the		
budget. Organizations appearing the reso that		
have not yet been completed pre-qualify will have		
an asterisk by their name. Additional with all		
transparency resolutions, Council Members have to		
sign a disclosure indicating whether a conflict		
exists. If a Council member has a potential		
conflict with an organization, he or she might		
want to disclose that on the record. Council		
Members are now required to disclose any conflicts		
they may have with proposed subcontractors. This		
disclosure must be made before the subcontractor		
will be approved. Members will be contacted by		
the Council of Ethics and Employment counsel,		
Nadir Joshua [phonetic] to complete the disclosure		
forms as necessary.		
Our last piece of legislation today		

Our last piece of legislation today is the Westchester Square BID. This preconsidered reso sets January 3rd at 10:00am as the date and time for a hearing on legislation that would establish the Westchester Square BID in Council Member Jimmy Vacca's district. If you

remember during the November 29th Finance hearing,
this Committee determined that the notifications
sent out by the Department of Small Business
Services about the October 17 th public hearings is
sufficient. This Committee has made another
hearing on the Westchester BID in order to give
the property owners and tenants in the proposed
BID an opportunity to be heard. SBS has been
directed to mail notices about the January 3 rd
hearing to all property owners and tenants in the
proposed BID. The first year budget for the BID
is \$320,000, with about 2/3 of its budget going
toward marketing and sanitation. Council Member
Vacca supports this wonderful BID and this
establishment.

Members of the City Council Finance
Division are here to answer any questions about
the transparency reso. HPD and SBS are here to
answer any questions you may have on the Land Use
item and the BID. Also, this is our last
Committee hearing of 2011. I want to wish
everyone a joyous and pleasant and blessed holiday
