23	COUNCIL MEMBER IGNIZIO: [off mic]
24	It's a meeting about something.
25	CHAIRPERSON RECCHIA: Right now,

most TLC licensed vehicle pay their tax to the New
York State Department of Motor Vehicle at the same
time that they register their vehicles with the
State. However, if these vehicles are not
registered within New York, the commercial New
York Motor Vehicle Tax remains unpaid by the
owners of the vehicles. Under this bill, the TLC
will now collect a commercial vehicle tax for the
TLC license medallion cabs and for-hire passenger
vehicles, such as liveries. If the tax is not
currently being collected by the DMV, this bill
ensures that if a TLC licensed vehicles operates
in New York, but is registered out of state, the
owner will be responsible for paying this tax.
There are approximately 1,500 livery cars that
have not paid this tax, which is set at \$400 for
livery car owners. This legislation is expected
to generate \$600,000 in FY 2013. For more details
of this legislation, the commercial vehicle tax,
please view the briefing report. Representatives
from TLC are here to answer any questions. Before
we hear from TLC, if anyone has any questions.
