25	Chairman. I'm Carol Clark, Assistant Commissioner

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of HPD, and as you noted, I'm joined by the Director of Operations of HPD, Gary Slomin, and John Kelly, a partner in the law firm of Nixon Peabody, who represents the owner of this property. It's known as Riverview Houses. an Article 5 redevelopment corporation. Way back in 1972 the Board of Estimate approved a redevelopment agreement between the housing company and the City of New York for a project located at 1600 Sedgwick Avenue, which contains a total of 383 rental dwelling units for low-income 13 families. The project was originally financed 14 with a HUD insured mortgage and is assisted by project-based Section 8. The agreement between the housing company and HPD was amended back in 1975 to allow HUD's supervision of the rents, and HPD today is before the Council seeking to amend and restate the agreement to reflect its current status, which includes a provision that residents who do not have Section 8 rental assistance cannot be charged rent greater than the rent set by HUD under the project-based Section 8 contract. Council Member Foster had indicated her support of the project, thank you.
