Chairperson of the City Council's Committee on

Housing and Buildings.

And today the Committee has before it two legislative items for the purposes of a vote, and they are Intro 791, which is a Local Law to amend the Code of the City of New York in relation to extending the rent stabilization laws, as well as Resolution number 1230, resolution to determine that a public emergency requiring rent control in the city of New York continues to exist and will continue to exist on and after April 1st of this calendar year.

The regulation of rents in the city of New York is of great concern to many New Yorkers. This Committee conducted an initial hearing on these items on March 2nd and received Commissioner Wambua's testimony from HPD, as well as from tenant leaders, housing advocates, and representatives of the real estate industry. As we heard at the time, the report of the Housing Vacancy Survey which was submitted by HPD

As everyone probably knows, the passage of 791, which I expect to pass today, would extend rent stabilization laws from April 1, 2012, to April 1, 2015; and the passage of the corresponding Reso would extend the rent control law from April 1, '12, to April 1, of '15 as well. At this point, if the sponsor of Reso 1230, Council Member Viverito, would like to make a brief statement, she may.
