6	CHAIRPERSON COMRIE: Oh, sorry.			
7	Let me introduce the members of the hearing.			
8	Council member Daniel Garodnick, Peter Koo, Lew			
9	Fidler, Vinny Ignizio, Mark Weprin, Charles			
10	Barron, Jimmy Vacca, Larry Seabrook, Joel Rivera,			
11	Al Vann, Diana Reyna, and Jessica Lappin. We have			
12	a few items before us this morning. First is Land			
13	Use No. 552, known as West Tremont Avenue, Bronx			
14	Community Board 5, in Council Member Foster's			
15	district, Item No. C120107HAX. It's dealing with			
16	92 West Tremont Avenue-			
17	[audio interference]			
18	CHAIRPERSON COMRIE:in Council			
19	District 16 to facilitate the development of a six			
20	story building with approximately 61 dwelling			
21	units. We also have a city-wide authorizing			
22	resolution, Land Use No. 590, Item No. 2012545			
23	authorizing franchises for DUIT to grant non-			
24	exclusive franchises for cable television			
25	services. This allows the Department of			

2	Information and Technology to have the authority		
3	to grant non-exclusive franchises for cable		
4	television services and all of that requires there		
5	within. I want to remind folks that all of these		
6	items have been fully vetted at the subcommittee		
7	meetings and today's meeting is to formally vote		
8	for them. We have the next item in Council Member		
9	Lew Fidler's district 46, Brooklyn Community Board		
10	18, Item No. C120108 ZMK. It's Land Use No. 595		
11	through 598, which are related. It's a no basin		
12	[phonetic] rezoning, demapping [phonetic]		
13	authorization and disposition to facilitate the		
14	development of an auto services establishments and		
15	also to continue the existence and sell Toys R Us		
16	Toys R Us could also purchase the land of		
17	approximately 106,781 square feet and reconfigure		
18	parking, and also a partial demapping of the		
19	street. And then we have Land Use Item No. 599,		
20	which is in my district, 11903 Springfield		
21	Boulevard in Queens Community Board 13, Item No.		
22	C090466 ZMQ. This is the rezoning to facilitate		
23	the construction of a two story medical office		
24	building in Cambria Heights, Queens. We have Land		
25	Use Item No. 602 known as Serafina; it's in the		

2	Speaker's district, Community Board 2, Item No.	
3	20125364 TCM to allow a sidewalk café to continue	
4	at Serafina Restaurant located at 7 Ninth Avenue.	
5	Finally, we have in Council Member Chin's	
6	district, Land Use No. 607, Community Board 1	
7	area, Item No. 20125571 PNM. It's an application	
8	to the maritime lease at the Battery Maritime	
9	Building between the Department of Small Business	
10	Services and the Governor's Island Trust for	
11	Governor's Island. It's a proposed lease to	
12	formalize and set forth the rights and	
13	responsibilities of the Trust in connection with	
14	its continued use of the Battery Maritime	
15	Building. That's everything on today's agenda. I	
16	would recommend a yes vote, and if anyone would	
17	like to speak to anything on today's agenda,	
18	please indicate now. Seeing that all members have	
19	talked about everything in the subcommittee	
20	meetings, I won't repeat what I said about my item	
21	either. I'll remind members that the next	
22	subcommittee meetings are May 22 nd and the next	
23	full Land Use Committee will be held on May 24 th .	
24	I recommend an aye vote, and then we can have the	
25	clerk call the roll. Mr. Martin?
