morning, and thank you for coming to today's hearing. My name is Council Member Julissa Ferreras, and I am the chair of the Women's Issues Committee. I'd like to thank my colleagues: Council Members Fidler, Vallone, Halloran and Gonzalez for co-sponsoring this resolution we're about to hear. Today's hearing is to vote on Reso No. 1346, which is a resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to pass and the governor to enact A. 9804 and S. 7212 also known as the Trafficking Victims Protection and Justice Act. This legislation seeks to improve upon existing state law clarifying certain portions of state law as well as address inconsistencies particularly in cases involving minors. yesterday's hearing on this resolution, the Brooklyn DA's office and several advocacy groups strongly supported this resolution and expressed their concerns that the bill currently undergoing negotiations in Albany will be watered down. Please let me stress that this resolution and we here at the Council, we are here to support the bill as written. We hope that the bill that is
