2 CHAIRPERSON KOPPELL: Good morning.

I'm Council Member Oliver Koppell, chair of the Council's Committee on Mental Health, Mental Retardation, Alcoholism, Drug Abuse and Disability Services. We are here today to vote on proposed Introduction 797, a local law to amend the administrative code in relation to requiring a sign at inaccessible building entrances, public toilets and elevators, giving directions to the nearest available accessible entrance or facility for persons with disabilities when such entrance or facility exists. In New York City, there are over 880,000 individuals with disabilities; estimated 60,000 New Yorkers are wheelchair users. The proposed Intro 797-A will make it easier for these New Yorkers to gain access to groceries stores, hotels, department stores, and cultural icons it says. I might say that this bill arose out of a hearing we held on accessible facilities in New York and I think it's the way legislation should develop. We will also vote on proposed Resolution 1229, a resolution recognizing September as Suicide Awareness Month in New York City and calling upon government agencies and non-

3	suicide. I talked about this at our hearing on			
4	Friday. I won't repeat that. I am pleased to say			
5	that at this early morning we have Council Member

9	Jennifer Wilcox and Michael Benjamin for arranging
