The resolution changes the name of the Committee of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, Alcoholism, Drug Abuse, and Disability Services to the Committee on Mental Health, Developmental Disability, Alcoholism, Drug Abuse, and Disability Services, and corrects various grammatical inconsistencies. CHAIRPERSON RIVERA: We're removing the term retardation and we're putting in the term developmentally disability, developmental disability.
