We have two items on today's
calendar: A resolution approving membership changes to certain standing committees and a subcommittee and chairs, and a resolution amending the Rules 7 of the Rules of the Council in relation to standing committees. The resolution changes the name of the Committee of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, Alcoholism, Drug Abuse, and Disability Services to the Committee on Mental Health, Developmental Disability, Alcoholism, Drug Abuse, and Disability Services, and corrects various grammatical inconsistencies. Does anybody have any questions on today's items? Council Member Jimmy Vacca.

COUNCIL MEMBER VACCA: What is the difference between the name?

CHAIRPERSON RIVERA: We're removing the term retardation and we're putting in the term developmentally disability, developmental disability.
