agenda, a transparency reso and two land use items. We'll start with the transparency reso. It sets forth changes in designations of certain organizations receiving local discretionary funding. Organizations appearing in the reso that have not yet completed the pre-qualification process by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services, the Council or any other entity are identified in the paperwork with an asterisk next to it.

Additionally, as with all transparency resos, Council Members will have to sign a disclosure form indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any of the groups on the attached list. If any Council Member has a potential conflict, he or she might want to disclose the conflict at the time of the vote.

A reminder, Council Members are not required to disclose any conflicts they may have with proposed subcontractors that are used by the organizations they sponsor for discretionary

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funding. This disclosure must be made before
subcontractors can be approved. Members will be
contacted by the Council's Ethics and Employment
Counsel Nadir to complete disclosure forms as
necessary.

Next, we have a land use item.

This property, named Associated Blind, is located in Speaker Quinn's district in Manhattan. The property will receive a 40-year partial property tax exemption the rehab of one building that will provide 205 units of rental housing for low-income seniors. Speaker Quinn supports this.

The next land use item is located in Speaker Quinn's district. The Clinton Housing development is one building that provides nine units of rental housing for low-income families. It will receive a 40-year full property tax exemption. Speaker Quinn approves this.

These are the only items on the agenda today. Members of the Council Finance are available to answer any questions you may have regarding the transparency reso and HPD is here to answer any questions. Does anybody have any questions?
