L6	today. We have two items on the agenda. A Land
L7	Use item and a Budget extender.
18	Before we start I want to introduce
19	my wonderful colleagues, Julissa Ferreras, Karen
20	Koslowitz, Helen Diane Foster, Joel Rivera, they
21	are making fun of the way I say Julissa's name,
22	Jimmy Van Bramer, Fernando Cabrera, Vincent
23	Ignizio and Jimmy Oddo who is on his way up.
24	Okay. Let's start with the Land
25	Use item Linden Harman is a property located in

Council member Diana Reyna and Erik Dilan's
district. This property which includes 18 units
of rental housing for low-income families will
undergo rehab and will receive a 40-year tax
exemption.

Our next piece of legislation is Executive Budget extender. The administration has asked to extend a day for submission of FY 2014 Executive Budget from April 26th to May 2nd. In order to give OMB time to incorporate information from this year's income tax returns into their revenue forecast for the Executive Budget. By providing the administration extra time to release the Executive Budget the council will need extra time to hold this Executive Budget hearings which will now conclude no later than June 6th rather than May 25th.

This legislation will also extend the other dates relating to Executive Budget actions taken by other officials such as the Independent Budget Office, Borough President.

Legislation also changed the target, budget adoption date submission of a revenue estimate and the date for fixing the tax rates from June 5th to

2	June $12^{ m th}$. So Wednesday, June $12^{ m th}$ is our goal for
3	budget adoption. Those are our items for today.
4	Representatives form HPD are here

to answer any questions. Representatives from OMB is here to answer any questions. Before we take questions I want to remind everyone tomorrow council will release its preliminary budget response. Okay, we're going to release our response that is in question to what the Mayor put out and the council here is on preliminary budget last of the month. Everything was put into a book by my wonderful finance staff.

We learned a lot over the course of the hearings and we hope that the suggestions and recommendations reflecting our budget response will significantly influence the Mayor's Executive Budget. Now, with that said, does anyone have any questions?
