9	Preconsidered resolution that calls upon the New
10	York State Legislature to enact the NYCHA Real
11	Property Public Review Act. This Act would
12	require NYCHA to follow the City's uniform land
13	use review procedure, otherwise known as ULURP,
14	whenever it seeks to dispose of its land or
15	buildings. The Committee previous considered this
16	resolution at our May 16th hearing, where we heard
17	testimony from NYCHA residents, resident
18	organizations, tenant advocates, community boards
19	and legal service providers. The witness
20	testimony was unanimously in support of this
21	resolution. The NYCHA Real Property Public Review
22	Act will give residents and community stakeholders
23	the opportunity to meaningfully impact NYCHA's
24	disposition plans and to play a significant role
25	in shaping our own neighborhoods. For this
