11740 and Senate Bill 3753, which would allow
municipalities to regulate pet dealers as long as
the law, rule, regulation or ordinance is not less

advocates and the Administration. This
legislation will help us improve conditions for
animals in New York City pet stores and impose
measures to help reduce the supply of animals that

Member Elizabeth Crowley and Jessica Lappin for
their leadership on this issue and I urge my
