Similarly, Intro 1080, a local law to amend the Administrative Code of the City of New York in relation to prohibiting bias based profiling, was passed by the Council on June 26th, 2013. The Mayor disapproved this bill on July 23rd, 2013; the Mayor accepted the veto on July 24th, 2013.

We will also be considering and voting on recommending to the Council whether Intro Number 1080 shall be passed, the objections of the Mayor notwithstanding.

I would ask that Council Members refrain from speaking and explaining their votes, as we will be moving directly from this meeting of the Committee of the Whole to the stated meeting where Council Member will have the opportunity to speak; I also
