

Transmitted here with are the bills signed by the Mayor. The bills are as follows:

Int. 143-A- Local Law 119

In relation to reporting response times for firefighting units and ambulances to fire and medical emergencies.

Int. 803-A- Local Law 120

In relation to requiring the Department of Correction to make its electronic database of people buried at Hart's Island, since 1977, available on its website.

Int. 804-A- Local Law 121

In relation to requiring the Department of Correction to put its Hart's Island visitation policy in writing, post it on its website, and make it available to anyone who requests a copy.

Int. 844-A- Local Law 122

In relation to an electric vehicle advisory committee.

Int. 925-A- Local Law 123

In relation to requiring the department of education to provide data regarding the provision of arts instructional requirements.

Int. 930-A- Local Law 124

In relation to reporting data regarding taxi and for hire vehicle inspections by the taxi and limousine commission.

Int. 1009-A- Local Law 125

In relation to an annual report on preferred source contract awards.

Int. 1091-A- Local Law 126

In relation to requiring the department of education to distribute information on college savings plans to all students.

Int. 1114-A- Local Law 127

In relation to a street design manual and to repeal subdivision d of section 19-180 of the administrative code of the city of New York as added by local law number 23 of 2008.

Int. 1140-A- Local Law 128

In relation to signs posted upon city-owned grassy areas adjacent to a street.

Int. 1172-A – Local Law 129

In relation to the regulation of lobbying, and to repeal section 3-214 of the administrative code of the city of New York, relating to the monthly docket of statements of registration required to be compiled by the city clerk.

Int. 1176-A - Local Law 130

In relation to electric vehicle charging stations in open parking lots and parking garages.

In relation to the naming of fifty-six thoroughfares and public places...

Int. 1191-A - Local Law 132

In relation to providing business owners the ability to indicate a language preference for agency inspections.
