2 CHAIRPERSON WEPRIN: Alright.

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Attentos [phonetic]. Buenos tardes, everybody. My name is Mark Weprin. I'm Chair of the Zoning and Franchises Subcommittee of the Land Use Committee, and we're here today on one item we already heard the hearing on, had the hearing on. I want to first say who's here to--from the Subcommittee, Council Member Joel Rivera, Diana Reyna, Robert Jackson, Al Vann, Dan Garodnick, Jessica Lappin and Vincent Ignizio, and I'm Mark Weprin. And we have three items all part of 77 Commercial Street, Land Use numbers 961, 962, and 963 in Council Member Levin's district, and as luck would have it Council Member Levin is here to my left and is going to speak on this item. The land use committee feels--there are many members of the Land Use Committee here, but I don't want to take that job away from Leroy Comrie. So we're very happy

COUNCIL MEMBER LEVIN: Thank you very much, Chair Weprin. My colleagues, first I want to thank you for your forbearance and for waiting for the process regarding this

to have all you Land Use people here.

SUBCOMMITTEE ON ZONING AND FRANCHISES development to play out, not only in the last several hours, but really over the last week, and so I want to thank you all very much for you taking the time and the patience with me. What we are voting on today is a fulfillment of an obligation that the City agreed to in 2005 to create meaningful affordable housing and open space in the Greenpoint Committee. What we are approving are technically a height and setback waivers, but what is essentially as part of this package is the transfer of air rights from a parcel of land that has been a MTA parking lot for the last 50 years or more, so that that area can be cleared out, the MTA vehicles to be relocated and that space to become open space park for the Greenpoint Community. We are moving the air rights to an adjacent lot, so the building there will be taller, but there's no change in density in the neighborhood. So there's significant affordable housing. There are 10 units at 40 percent of AMI, 10 units at 50 percent of AMI, 80 units at 60 percent of AMI, 26 units at 80 percent of

AMI, 34 units at 100 percent of AMI, and 40

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this item.

5 units at 120 percent of AMI, 125 percent of AMI, excuse me, and that is in line with for the most part the points of agreement that were reached between the administration and the community back in 2005 and this council was a part of. And so, this has been a long arduous process. I want thank the developer for their patience in working with us, and also I want to thank especially Carolee Fink [phonetic] from the Mayor's office, Deputy Mayor Steele's office, because Carolee put in, I think, potentially 100 or more hours into this negotiation. And so I want to acknowledge the hard work that she did and congratulate here on making this happen. So with that, Mr. Chairman, I'll turn it back over to you, and I recommend or I request that my colleagues vote aye on
