This bill will require that when the Department of Buildings receives an application either for the new construction of or for the converse--conversion of a building to a transit hotel, the DOB must provide written notice to the borough president, the Councilman of the district where the construction is located, as well as the relevant community board. the construction will straddle two or more districts, the borough board must also be notified.

I believe this bill will inform and empower the community as well as local elected officials about the changes occurring in their community, and ask that my colleagues support this bill. It happens to be a bill that I sponsored.
