The Cooper Square Committee and the Ali Forney Center are co-developing the Bea Arthur Residence project at 222 East 13th Street in Manhattan. The building, which is currently a city-owned townhouse that has been vacant for two decades, will provide transitional housing for 18 homeless LGBT youth, ages 18 – 24.

The Cooper Square Committee has sponsored the renovation and development of over 580 low income housing units in the East Village/Lower East Side since the early 1980s. More than 380 of these low income housing units are managed by a Mutual Housing Association that we created in 1991. The Ali Forney Center has been in existence since 2002, named after the young man who advocated for homeless LGBT youth, and who was murdered in 1997. The AFC assists nearly 1,400 youth per year through 10 housing sites and a multi-purpose drop in center. They provide a continuum of care for LGBT youth, many of them kicked out by their parents, to help them prepare for independent living.

In Fiscal Year 2013, CSC and AFC were awarded \$3 million in capital funds by the City Council, and \$300,000 by the Manhattan Borough President to fund this transitional housing project. We then assembled a development team, including the architectural firm Magnusson Architecture and Planning and the legal services of the Lawyers Alliance of New York, which helped us form the Bea Arthur Residence Housing Development Fund Corporation. The architectural plans call for enlarging the vacant 3 story, 4,900 sq. ft. building in the rear, adding over 1,100 sq. ft. so that we can provide three 3-bedroom apartments of about 1,150 sq. ft. each. Each apartment will provide affordable low income housing to 6 homeless LGBT youth. Each resident will pay a rent of \$200 per month. The AFC will occupy the basement space, and will provide case management services pursuant to a HUD contract, ensuring that each of the residents completes their High School education, and obtains employment. 75% of AFC's clients go on to college.

The building has been filed as a Building Code Use Group R-1 (Congregate Living). We have also made the building ADA compliant by including a lift at the entrance into the basement space, and a limited use limited access elevator or LULA from the basement to the first floor in order to make $1/3^{rd}$ of the units fully accessible.

We have selected Builders R Us, a minority business enterprise, as the general contractor. They were the lowest qualified bidder with a \$2.503 million bid. When you add the 10% contingency requirement and soft costs, the total development cost comes to \$3,340,000. We have obtained a small \$40,000 loan from a private source to cover the funding gap. We will also be utilizing the services of the Weatherization Assistance Program, administered by the Northern Manhattan Improvement Corporation, which will install the energy efficient windows and provide the thermal insulation. They will ensure the building complies with Enterprise Green Communities criteria.

The project is expected to be completed in 12 months. We look forward to closing by the end of June. We thank the City Council for your generous support for this pioneering project, which aims to address the crisis of homelessness among young adults, particularly in the LGBT community, which comprises up to 40% of all homeless youth.

A Plan for 222 East 13th Street:

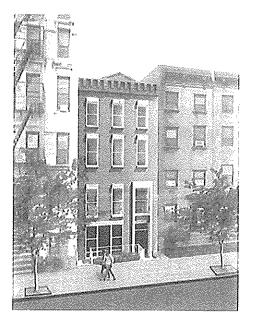
The Cooper Square Committee, a housing preservation organization, and the Ali Forney Center, an organization that serves homeless LGBT youth, have a plan to renovate 22 East 13th Street in order to provide quality, safe, transitional housing for homeless LGBT teenagers and young adults, (ages 18 – 24).



There are an estimated 4,000 homeless teenagers in NYC. According to a 2008 Census survey, up to 40% (1,600 homeless teenagers) are LGBT. As LGBT youth come out earlier, unfortunately some of them face rejection by their parents and are forced out onto the streets. These otherwise high functioning young people are placed at risk.

They need a safe environment, which this housing will provide, so that they can prepare for adulthood.

This 4 story city-owned building has been vacant for nearly 20 years. It is an eye-sore on an otherwise solid, attractive block. Our organizations have raised \$3.3 million in City funds, and have filed renovation plans with the NYC Department of Buildings. The building, which is about 4,900 sq. ft., will be enlarged in the rear to create a 6,000 sq. ft. building.



It will contain basement programming space provided by the Ali Forney Center, and three 3-bedroom apartments, each of which will house 6 LGBT youths, for a total of 18 residents.

The renovation of 222 East 13th Street will restore this historic building, dating from 1851, and provide 18 young adults with a safe, secure home where they can live free of stigma, and make plans for their future.
