CHAIRPERSON EUGENE: Good morning. Council Member Mathieu Eugene, Chair of the Committee on Youth Services. This morning we will vote on two bills that will improve services Runaway and Homeless Youth. Proposed Intro 1619-A, sponsored by Council Member Johnson, would require DYCD to report the number of youth who are not able to access bed and the Runaway and Homeless Youth shelter services. This bill will better enable the City of New York understand the size of this population, and what additional services are needed to ensure that all youth who need a bed are able to access one. And we ae also voting on Proposed Intro 1705-A sponsored by Council Member Salamanca, which requires DYCD and DHS to develop a system to alert youth who have reached the age of time limits and are in RHY shelters to directly enter a DHS shelter, and by passing the DHS entry and assessment facilities. I want to thank our-the Sponsors of this bill Council Member Salamanca and Council Member Johnson for their work, and I urge my colleagues to vote yes. But before we vote, I want to take the opportunity to thank also

It is inconceivable that this could be allowed in New York City. These young people are among the most vulnerable members of our society, and we have a special responsibilty to take care for them, to keep them safe and to let them know that they are valued and loved. Our city has allocated significant resources to this issue in recent years expanding the
