CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Okay, good morning, and welcome to today's Finance Committee meeting. name is Council Member Daniel Dromm, and I'm the chair of the committee. We've been joined this morning by Council Member Robert Cornegy, Council Member Keith Powers, Council Member Adrienne Adams, Council Member Jimmy Van Bramer, Council Member Steve Matteo and Council Member Barry Gordenchik. you for joining us and we expect other members to be with us shortly. Today, the committee will be voting on three items, a transparency resolution and two Article XI property tax exemptions. Let's start with the transparency resolution, which sets for the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local, aging and youth discretionary funding and funding pursuant to certain initiatives in the budget. Organizations appearing in the resolution that have not yet completed the prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services, the Council or otheranother entity are—are identified in the attached charts with an asterisk. As with all transparency resolutions, Council Members will have to sign a

2 disclosure form indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any of the groups on the attached list. 3 If any Council Member has been-has a potential 4 conflict of interest with any of the organizations 5 6 listed, he or she has the opportunity to disclose the 7 conflict at the time of their vote. As a reminder, please disclose any conflicts you may have with 8 proposed subcontractors used by organizations 9 sponsored by discretionary funding. 10 disclosures must be made before the subcontractor can 11 12 be approved. Benjamin Smith from the General 13 Counsel's Office is here, and can assist you with any 14 questions or concerns regarding disclosures. Next, 15 we have the Land Use Items. The first is Breaking Ground, 90 Sand Street in Council Member Levin's 16 17 district in Brooklyn, which would provide a full 40-18 year Article XI tax exemption to support the preservation of 508 units of affordable housing-19 20 rental housing. The second is The Astra, 645 Gates Avenue in Council Member Cornegy's district in 21 2.2 Brooklyn, which would provide a fully 40-year Article 23 XI tax exemption to support the new construction 112 units of affordable rental housing. Both of the 24 Council Members are supportive of the projects in
