Finance Committee hearing. My name is David

Weprin; I chair the Committee. Today we have two

Land Use items on the agenda, which will provide

property tax exemptions to persons of low income.

This Committee originally also scheduled the pre
considered Resolution to establish the Belmont bid

in Council Member Joel Rivera's district. But due

to notice requirements we must postpone the vote

on the pre-considered Resolution until next month.

The first Land Use item is the POKO South Bronx Condos II, which will consist of one-to four-family homes that will provide 32 units of affordable home ownership to persons of low income. The sponsor, Bronx Condo Owners LLC, purchased city owned land under HPD's New Foundations program to develop the project. In order to keep the project financially viable and provide affordable home ownership opportunities

for persons of low income, HPD is requesting a tax exemption pursuant to Section 696 of the Private Housing Finance Law.

The second Land Use item is the Longwood Gardens Building, which will provide 25 units of rental housing for low-income families. The owner and sponsor, TNS Development Group Ltd., will develop the project under HPD's Construction Participation Loan program. In order to keep the project financially viable and provide affordable housing, HPD is requesting a tax exemption pursuant to Section 577 of the Private Housing Finance Law.

Both Land Use items are in Council Member Maria del Carmen Arroyo's district and she supports these projects. Members from Council of Finance are available to answer any questions on these two Land Use items.
