Transmitted herewith are the bills signed by the Mayor. The bills are as follows:

# <u>Int 492-A – Local Law 57</u>

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to requiring the police department to submit to the council reports of crime involving illegally obtained firearms.

## **Int. 808 – Local Law 58**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of the Belmont business improvement district.

### **Int 812-A – Local Law 59**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to allowing parking at missing or broken meters or muni-meters up to the maximum time permitted in that parking meter zone.

# <u>Int. 841 – Local Law 60</u>

A Local Law to amend the administration code of the city of New York, in relation to authorizing an increase in the amount to be expended in thirteen business improvement districts.

# Int 860 - Local Law 61

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the industrial and commercial abatement program.
