LU numbers 923 and 924 is the East Village, Lower East Side rezoning. They are two related actions, amendments to the zoning map and an amendment to the zoning resolution. It is in Council Member Mendez and Council Member Gerson's district.

LU number 921, 925 and 926 are all related. It is a special permit, site selection and an acquisition. It is three related actions to facilitate the construction of a sanitation garage.

COUNCIL MEMBER BREWER: As a project in my district I won't belabor it because I spoke at the sub-committee and I will speak on the floor. But just for those of you who have nick Housing Authority developments in your district and who are on the list for projects to be bought and built in these communities, I'd like to say that this is a precedent setting. In addition, it was part of the Hudson Yards
