In my opinion, it really goes to the heart of this administration moving 19 2.0 negative facilities from one district to another. 21 The city spend a huge amount of money 22 rehabilitating this tow pound in my district. 23 is actually a decent facility now. But what they 24 want to do is move it to somebody else and then 25 stick something else in my district, which is the

Member Mendez represents. So it is a real loss to
our neighborhood. One point I wanted to make
today, and it's not really specific to the
application, but this is a school building that is
now going to be vacant at some point. It's an
obvious choice for the Department of Education to
locate a school in that building. I have made
this point directly to the chancellor and our
working group with all of the East Side elected
officials. We repeatedly make this point. I
wanted to make it here today. It's an important
one and the space is ready to go. Thank you. I
vote aye.
