Transmitted herewith are the bills signed by the Mayor. The bills are as follows:

Intro 842 - Local Law 62

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to the establishment of the Fulton Street business improvement district.

Intro 848 - Local Law 63

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to regionally significant projects and empire zones.

Intro 877-A - Local Law 64

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to the naming of 49 thoroughfares and public places.

Intro 879-A - Local Law 65

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to an increase in the rate of the additional tax on the occupancy of hotel rooms imposed by chapter 25 of title 11 of such code.

Intro 887 - Local Law 66

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, to provide for the levy and collection of additional real property taxes for fiscal year 2009, and to amend the administrative code of the city of New York and the New York City charter in relation to the date when taxes are due and payable.

Intro 888 - Local Law 67

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to the participation of minority-and women-owned business enterprises in construction projects related to properties receiving tax benefits in accordance with the industrial and commercial abatement program.

Intro 895 - Local Law 68

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to suspending alternate side of the street parking rules during snowfalls.
