CHAIRPERSON CORNEGY: Good morning, everyone, and thank you for coming. I'm Council Member Robert Cornegy, Chair of the Council's Committee on Housing and Buildings. We're here to hold a vote on proposed Intro No. 342-A sponsored by Council Member Debi Rose, which relates to building accessibility. Many buildings constructed before 1990, when the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act became effective, do not have permanent ramps at entrances to ensure accessibility. Instead, many of these buildings provide portable ramps, which can be available upon request. However, it's often unclear whether a portable ramp is available at a given entrance and who to contact to request it. Proposed Intro No. 342-A would require buildings that provide portable ramps to post at each inaccessible entrance that a portable ramp is available, and the number to call to request it. would also clarify the requirements for portable ramps to ensure that they are un-that they are usable and safe.
