Council Member Peter Koo, and I'm pleased to join the-the Chair of the Committee on Parks and Recreation, and we are joined by Council Members Adams, Rivera, Brannan, Moya, and Ulrich. Today we will consider and vote on three important pieces of legislation. Proposed Introduction No. 1009-A sponsored by Council Member Steven Matter will require the Parks Department to provide an automated external defibrillator or AED at every large pool facility under its jurisdiction, and to have at least one employee trained to use AD-AED present during all hours of pool supervision. Proposed Introduction No. 1042-A also sponsored by Council Member Steven Matteo will permit the Department of Citywide Administrative Services and Parks Department to distribute any extra AEDs they possess to any youth sponsored leagues after they first fulfill their obligation to provide AEDs to youth baseball and softball leagues.
