WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 7, 2005 its approval of the petition of 107-02 Queens Blvd. Corp., d/b/a Il Pescatore, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed small sidewalk café located at 107-02 Queens Boulevard, Community District 6, Borough of Queens (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
