A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to special parking for accessible for-hire vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-164 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as

follows:

§19-164 Special parking for wheelchair accessible vans <u>and accessible vehicles</u>. Any wheelchair accessible van <u>or accessible vehicle</u>, as such term is defined in section 19-534 of this title, licensed by the taxi and limousine commission actually in the process of boarding or discharging [wheelchair passengers] <u>physically disabled persons</u>, or escorting [wheelchair passengers] <u>such persons</u> to and from their destination, shall be permitted to park in any <u>no standing zone</u>, <u>bicycle lane</u>, <u>or</u> area in which a vehicle with a special

vehicle identification permit is permitted to park.

§2. This local law shall take effect ninety days after it is enacted into law.
