WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on June 22, 2012 a copy of its designation dated June 12, 2012 (the "Designation"), of the Hotel Mansfield (now The Mansfield Hotel) located at 12 West 44th Street (aka 12-14 West 44th Street), Community District 5, Borough of Manhattan as a landmark and Tax Map Block 1259, Lot 47, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 10, 2012, its report on the Designation dated August 8, 2012 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on September 5, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:
