WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on November 14, 2012 its approval dated November 14, 2012 of the petition of 14 Bar, LLC, d/b/a The Double Seven, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 63 Gansevoort Street, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(e) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, by letter dated December 7, 2012, and submitted to the City Council on December 11, 2012, the applicant withdrew its application for the revocable consent.
