WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on November 14, 2012 its approval dated November 14, 2012 of the petition of Olio Restaurants, LLC, d/b/a Olio, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 3 Greenwich Avenue, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
